Is it necessarily true that the function \$f\$ is increasing? Is it necessary and sufficient for \$f\$ to be increasing? I know the necessity. In fact, if \$f\$ is increasing, then by the intermediate value theorem, there exists an \$x\in[a,b]\$ such that f(a)=f(x) and f(b)=f(x). Since f'(x)>0, we have f(x)>f(a)=f(b). This is a contradiction. A: For a counterexample, set  $f(x)=\sin(2\pi x)$ . The derivative is \$2\pi \cos(2\pi x)\$ which is \$0\$ if \$x\$ is rational and positive for irrational \$x\$. But \$f\$ is increasing for irrational \$x\$: for \$x\_1, x\_2\$ irrational with \$x\_1 \sin(2\pi x\_1)\$ by the intermediate value theorem. 
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
